The Valley View shelter house was erected in the Oakdale Park by Elvera (Reimers) Larson (and her children Cheryl, Bruce, Audrey, and Donna) in memory of her husband, Eldon Larson, and in memory of her mother, Betty (Mrs. Oscar) Reimers. A special service of dedication was held 49 years ago on Sunday, September 12, 1971. The large windows overlooking Mill Creek have made Valley View a welcoming place for many church and family events. The contractor was Delmer Dau of Primghar with many loyal Oakdale hands in the construction. Today, we give gratitude to Elvera's children and her sisters, Elsie Wester and Eleda Wester, and also to Elvera and Eldon's niece and nephew, Cindy Mogensen and Mark Carlson. Thank you.
